

Regular events during the week - please check the weekly sheets to see what is running this week

Monday

9.30am Playcentre (Dosthill)

Parents can drop their children (aged 2 up) off for a time of play and learning. During term time only.

3.45 to 5pm Messy Church, (Dosthill)

A time for families to come and enjoy craft, games, bible stories and a simple meal together. Once a month at the Dosthill building,

7.30pm Prayer Meeting (Dosthill)

A time to spend longer in prayer together. They are led by different people and encourage us to think about different things each time. No need to be an expert in prayer to come along, in fact you don't need to say anything at all - just listen if you want.

8.00pm Men's Fellowship (Belgrave)

A time for men to get together, share experiences, and focus on our Christian faith. Sometimes there is a meal, an invited speaker, or even friendly competition! Monthly.

10.00am Craft Sessions (Belgrave)

An informal time where people gather to do their craft, share ideas and have a good chat.

At our Dosthill building: drop in for a coffee and cake - usually home made!

For men: at ABs in Ankerside

For women: at Druckers in Ankerside

6.00pm Girls' Brigade (Belgrave)

A uniformed group with a mix of activities including games, badge work, learning more about God. For girls age 5 and up - please ask for the start time for the different age groups. During term time only.

Baptist churches make their plans and decisions at a meeting of the "members" who have committed to belong to the local church. Everyone is welcome, but only members can vote. Every other month.

7.30pm Tamworth Signs for Worship (Belgrave)

A time of worship and learning that is accessible to those who use British Sign Language or spoken English.

Saturday

8.30am Prayer Breakfast (Belgrave)

Time of prayer followed by breakfast. Monthly.

9am Men's Breakfast: Red Lion, Hopwas

Every other month on the third Saturday. Cost £5.45.

Housegroups

We have several groups that meet during the week in people's houses to share, study the bible, pray and build friendships. They are informal, small, friendly groups and are a good way to get to know people.

We have lots going on and you are welcome to join us for any of these. But joining any new group can be daunting so please do say if you want to be put in touch with someone who can tell you more and perhaps take you along.

A time to go a little more in depth into the bible.


Children's activities on Sundays
