Questions to help you think about today's teaching - to discuss in housegroups, or use at home:

Holiness, cleansing and call (Isaiah 6:1-13)

1. This is a powerful and strange story. What particularly speaks to you from it?
2. Have we lost at all a proper appreciation of God's holiness and our sinfulness?
3. How should God's words to Isaiah about people not repenting and returning – even his preaching seeming to push them away – inform how we speak with people today about God?

Focus on communion (Mark 14:17-26)

4. How shocking would it have been for Jesus to claim that he could forgive sin (Mark 2:10)? How much do we forget the reality and seriousness of sin?
5. How would you have responded if you had heard Jesus speaking about his impending rejection, suffering and death (Mark 8:31, 9:31; 10:33)? How do you respond today?
6. How does the hope we have in Jesus (Mark 13:26-27; 14:62) encourage you and challenge you?
