Questions to help you think about today's teaching - to discuss in housegroups, or use at home:

1. Forgiving those who sin against us (Matthew 6:11)
2. How easy do you find it to forgive others? What things make it more difficult?
3. How much knowing you have been forgiven by God give you an incentive to forgive others?
4. If you have realised that there is someone you need to forgive – maybe someone you haven't been able to for a long time – what are you going to do about it?

Living as new people (Ephesians 4:17-32)

1. What, for you, is involved in "putting off" your old self and "putting on" the new self (vv22-24)?
2. How much does being "members of one body" (v25) reinforce the need to behave kindly and compassionately (v32) towards each other?
3. Of the things Paul calls for in verses 25-31 which do you find most difficult? Have you found ways to do it? How could your small group help you in doing so?
