Questions to help you think about today's teaching - to discuss in housegroups, or use at home:

Disciples making disciples (Matthew 28:16-20)

1. How would you describe the role of a disciple of Jesus? Is it something we are called to be today?
2. How do you respond to the call of Jesus to "go and make disciples"?
3. How do / could small groups – in whatever form – help us in living as disciples and making disciples?

Living in God's power (Ephesians 6:10-24)

4. Paul encourages us to put on the armour God provides and to pray. Why are these so necessary?
5. How much do we really protect ourselves with God's armour and how much do we "pray in the Spirit on all occasions" (v18)? If not, why not?
6. Paul's request for prayer was that he would be able to powerfully proclaim the gospel (v19-20). What sort of things do we ask people to pray for? How does Paul's example challenge us?
