## **Questions to help you think about today's teaching - to discuss in housegroups, or use at home:**

Go and make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:16-20)

1. What can we do to support those involved in making disciples in other parts of the world?
2. In which part of our "own world" do we find it most difficult to act as disciple-makers and why? What help do we need?
3. In which parts of our "own world" do we have most opportunities to make disciples? How are we going to approach this?

4. How would you speak with someone about the need of repentance, of turning to Jesus for forgiveness of sin, of being baptised?
5. Do you want to be more obedient to the commands of Jesus? If so, what are you going to do about that?
6. What are the challenges you see in encouraging others to do what Jesus commanded? What are good ways of approaching this?


