## **Questions to help you think about today’s teaching – to discuss in groups, or use at home.**

Psalm 40:1 – 3; Colossians 3:1 – 8

1. The testimony in Psalm describes what happened when God intervened in the writer’s life so dramatically, that it influenced many other people to turn to the Lord themselves. What contemporary examples of this do you know?
2. Our reading in Colossians 3 urges us to ‘set our minds on things above’. What does this involve, and how do we avoid the risk of being ‘so heavenly minded that we are of no earthly good.?’
3. Paul urges us to ‘take off our old self’ and to ‘put on the new self’. In Colossians 3:11 he sets aside racial, religious, social, and cultural divides – urging us to seek a new relationships based on what we have in common in Christ. What are the divides we should be setting aside in our world today?
