Dear friends,

Thank you to all who have been contacting us asking after our welfare. We really appreciate your love and prayers.

We are well, quarantined in our homes for over a week now, busy with home school, board games and keeping in touch electronically. Children are not allowed to leave the house. Our streets are patrolled by the police and army and adults are allowed to make visits to top up on groceries, to pharmacies and the bank. There are between 1-10 cases of COVID-19 in Iquitos depending on who you speak to.

Generally, people are complying with the restrictions though it took the forceful presence of the police and army before this was the case. The mood is peaceful and calm on the whole, with neighbours looking out for each other a little more. However, we are fighting against fear and discouragement, as well as boredom from being stuck at home.

We are in good spirits though, with Facebook, phone calls and WhatsApp messaging aiding our fellowship with friends and family. Watching online sermons has also been a great source of encouragement.

Please pray for the 400+ UK tourists stranded in Peru, hoping to get home sometime this week.

Pray for us as we seek new ways of continuing our ministry using new methods of communication.

We pray for healing to come through the discovery of an effective vaccine soon, for the love of God to abound worldwide, and for many to find salvation in Christ at this time of crisis. May we all experience more of God's grace and mercy every single day. We will endeavour to keep you updated.
