BMS APPEAL

BMS World Mission is working in around 30 countries on four continents. This year their appeal is looking to fund vaccinations around the world. Today's offerings will enable BMS to do the following:

- £10 will allow one healthcare worker to attend vaccination training in South Lalitpur, Nepal
- £15 will sponsor a training session for five adults in Albania on good hygiene and Covid-19 awareness
- £25 will provide a month's counselling for victims of gender-based violence and Covid-19 in Uganda
- £75 will purchase a portable vaccine box for local health workers in Rukum, Nepal
- £120 will allow BMS partners to meet with the Ministry of Health and to lobby for policies that guarantee vaccine accessibility in Uganda
