

Gift Aid and Financial Support for the church

On a Sunday morning a number of people support the work of the church by giving a cash offering. Others give their gifts directly into the church's bank account. However, if you are a taxpayer, you can increase your giving to the church by 25% by completing a Gift Aid declaration. A number of people already do this allowing the church to reclaim about £9,000 a year. These Gift Aid declarations cost you nothing and are not a long-term commitment. You would still be free to amend your offering at any time.

If you are a taxpayer and would like the church to reclaim some of the tax you pay, please speak to one of the deacons for more details.

If you would prefer to give directly to the church's bank account, the details of the church's Co-operative Bank account are given below:

Even if you are not a taxpayer your cash gifts will be boosted by 25% under the Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme. There is a limit to those donations however which is currently £8,000 and in the last tax year these gifts totalled almost £7,300. This is another reason why we would encourage taxpayers to complete a Gift Aid declaration.
