Thy Kingdom Come

As a church we are going to take part in a global prayer initiative called "Thy Kingdom Come" from **14th-24th May**. This year's theme is 'God with us'. There are various ways that you can get involved. One is to use a physical prayer journal. There is one for adults, a Digital Detox journal for young people and a prayer journal for children as well. I will be giving these out on **Sunday 3rd May and Sunday 10th May**. There is also a free "Thy Kingdom Come" app for your phone which is packed with inspirational films, prayers, Bible readings, reflections and space to 'Pray for Five'. Search for "Thy Kingdom Come" in your app store.

The youth and children will use some of the resources in their groups on a Sunday and the prayer afternoon on **Wednesday 20th May from 1.30pm till 4.30pm** will have prayer stations based on the themes from "Thy Kingdom Come".

Another aspect of this prayer initiative is the encouragement to **pray for 5 people** that you know and care about who do not know Jesus yet, that God will work in their lives and reveal Himself to them. There is a small card on which you can write their names and put it somewhere where you will see it to remind you to keep praying for them. Above all during this time, let's use it to pray, *"Thy Kingdom Come; Thy will be done here in Tamworth as it is in heaven."*
